Fund Development

The Valley Hospice Foundation receives gifts through a mix of fundraising practices that includes: special events, mail appeals, major gifts, planned giving and bequests.

In 2019/20 our fundraising plan was guided by the Foundation's commitment to the building of Valley Hospice and its ability to care for the dying, and also to assisting loved ones and the surrounding community.

Highlighted in that plan was the meaningful acknowledgement of our supporters. To that end a new Donation Acceptance Policy and Donor Recognition Policy has completed and approved. Moving forward there will be a virtual donor wall added to the Valley Hospice Foundation's website.

In the fall of 2019, the Fund Development committee introduced the Circle of Care – monthly giving program and completed a tool kit to assist 3rd party fundraising among community groups and others who wish to help the hospice.

We thank our volunteers and community for their continued support of all our fundraising efforts and their participation in our annual events including Hike for Hospice (\$21,428 net income) and Holiday Gala (\$16,056 net income)

The committee meets every two to four weeks. It has covered all aspects of the project, from choosing the site, working through the design, to selecting furniture! After months of work, the final design was completed in the summer of 2018. The tender was then called and a contract was awarded to Rikjak Construction Limited in the fall of 2018. The official “sod turning” on October 26, 2018 was the start of the next phase. The construction has continued, and is now substantially complete. The official opening of the facility has been delayed because of the Covid19 outbreak.

We would like to thank all the members of the Project Advisory Committee for helping ensure the Valley Hospice is a warm, friendly and homelike environment for those in need.

Don Wells, Chair, Nominating Committee

As of March 31 2020 assets for Valley Hospice Foundation were: \$2,519,199.

- \$2 million is committed to the Nova Scotia Health Authority (NSHA) for the construction of the residential Hospice. In 2017/18 \$2 million was paid to begin the project.

A formal agreement between the Valley Hospice Foundation and NSHA states that additional installments will be made by the Foundation as billed by NSHA up to a total contribution of \$4 million. A final invoice for the construction is currently being reviewed by the Board representative of the Advisory Committee prior to approval for a final payment.

- A grant in the amount of \$10,000 was provided to the Friends in Bereavement Support Groups. Grief support groups are held twice a month in Kentville, Berwick and Bridgetown. The group provides support for those who are grieving the death or approaching death of a loved one. The sessions are a balance of learning and informal conversation.

Funds valued at \$2,519,199 are invested and managed by Scotia Wealth Management using a low risk asset mix of: 80% Fixed/20% Equities.

The Valley Hospice Foundation's audited statements are available to the public for review.
